**The Socratic Problem** Oct 13 2021 This work is intended to offer to anyone still intending to devote himself to the Socratic problem a reliable means of approach by providing, first of all, a complete history of the problem itself, from its first appearance during Socrates' lifetime up to the present day. The book provides not only the history of the problem, but also the essential documents, accompanied by brief explanatory and bibliographical contextual notes, to be read in counterpoint with the chapters of its history. These documents consist of 61 extracts from 54 authors, from Fréret onwards, in other words, from the beginning of the history of the problem of the socratic sources, which arose in the Age of Enlightenment, down to the present day. These extracts are not intended to form a collection of the various representations, interpretations or images of Socrates which succeeded each other in the history of socratic historiography; instead, the aim is to present, in a logically and chronologically consistent order, the various ways in which the problem of the sources of Socratism was presented and resolved in the course of two hundred years of study and research on the 'case' of Socrates.

*Identity and Identification* Jan 04 2021 This work is an exegetical and theological study of 2Sam 21-24. These chapters, usually called the appendix of Samuel have been given relatively little attention in Old Testament scholarship. Nevertheless, the very marginality of this

sequence turns out to be of heuristic value and its intrusiveness reveals itself as an interpretative key to the understanding of the whole book they conclude. In this study on the one hand it is discussed how foreigners are visualised, directly or indirectly, and on the other, how David is represented as an Identifikationsfigur. It would seem probable that 2 Sam 21-24 was added partly to create a book and so it also bears on the non-cultic use of the psalms in the post-exilic period. Laszlo T. Simon was born in Győr (Hungary) in 1963. He joined the Benedictine order in 1982. After earning a licentiate in biblical theology at the Gregorian University he studied literature in Budapest, and then he taught English and literature in one of the high schools run by his order. In 1998 he returned to Rome and with the present dissertation gained the doctorate in biblical theology.

**Tracing the Path of Tolerance** Jul 22 2022 In the globalized, postmodern world, the production of encounters and clashes between dissimilar cultures, ways of life, and systems of values has drastically increased in number. More and more frequently, they originate harsh conflicts, exhibiting the existence of alternative and apparently incompatible ways of living and thinking – culturally, religiously, economically and politically speaking. *Socialism of Fools* Jul 10 2021 In *Socialism of Fools*, Michele Battini focuses on the critical moment during the Enlightenment in which anti-Jewish stereotypes morphed into a sophisticated, modern social anti-Semitism. He recovers the potent anti-Jewish, anticapitalist propaganda that cemented the idea of a Jewish conspiracy in the European mind and connects it to the atrocities that characterized the Jewish experience in the nineteenth and twentieth centuries. Beginning in the eighteenth century, counter-Enlightenment intellectuals and intransigent Catholic writers singled out Jews for conspiring to exploit self-sustaining markets and the liberal state. These ideas spread among socialist and labor movements in the nineteenth century and intensified during the Long Depression of the 1870s. Anti-Jewish anticapitalism then migrated to the Habsburg Empire with the Christian Social Party; to Germany with the Anti-Semitic Leagues; to France with the nationalist movements; and to Italy, where Revolutionary Syndicalists made anti-Jewish anticapitalism the basis of an alliance with the nationalists. Exemplified best in the Protocols of the Elders of Zion, the infamous document that "leaked" Jewish plans to conquer the world, the Jewish-conspiracy myth inverts reality and creates a perverse relationship to historical and judicial truth. Isolating the intellectual roots of this phenomenon and its contemporary resonances, Battini shows us why, so many decades after the Holocaust, Jewish people continue to be a powerful political target.

**The Business of the Roman Inquisition in the Early Modern Era** Jan 16 2022 Established in 1542, the Roman Inquisition operated through a network of almost fifty tribunals to combat heretical and heterodox threats within the papal territories. Whilst its theological, institutional and political aspects have been well-studied, until now no sustained work has been undertaken to understand the financial basis upon which it operated. Yet – as *The Business of the Roman Inquisition in the Early Modern Era* shows – the fiscal autonomy enjoyed by each tribunal was a major factor in determining how the Inquisition operated. For, as the flow of cash from Rome declined, each tribunal was forced to rely upon its own assets and resources to fund its work, resulting in a situation whereby tribunals increasingly came to resemble businesses. As each tribunal was permitted to keep a substantial proportion of the fines and confiscations it levied, questions quickly arose regarding the economic considerations that may have motivated the Inquisition's actions. Dr Maifreda argues that the Inquisition, with the need to generate sufficient revenue to continue working, had a clear incentive to target wealthy groups within society who could afford to yield up substantial revenues. Furthermore, as secular authorities also began to rely upon a levy on these revenues, the financial considerations of decisions regarding heresy prosecutions become even greater. Based upon a wealth of hitherto neglected primary sources from the Vatican and local Italian archives, Dr Maifreda reveals the underlying financial structures that played a vital part in the operations of the Roman Inquisition. By exploring the system of incentives and pressures that guided the actions of inquisitors in their procedural processes and choice of victims, a much clearer understanding of the Roman Inquisition emerges. "INTOLLERANZA@ETICA -cause e effetti dell'intolleranza etnica, razziale, religiosa- ". Si tratta di un lavoro che verte sui problemi d'intolleranza violenta che in epoca attuale affliggono le società occidentali con alto tenore di vita. Negli ultimi decenni, parallelamente al crescere dei fenomeni immigratori, sono aumentati gli episodi di intolleranza etnica, razziale, religiosa. Ho cercato di compiere una ricerca che partisse da due fronti apparentemente separati: l'analisi dei rapporti che legano l'individuo all'ambiente in cui vive; le cause che permettono alle idee d'intolleranza di radicarsi stabilmente a livello di coscienza e non essere più rimosse. Un altro aspetto trattato, strettamente correlato alle tematiche descritte, è stata la "religiosità" che ha rappresentato il primo collante ideologico per le comunità primordiali che man mano si formavano. La necessità di aggregarsi in gruppi coesi aveva permesso il formarsi di una moralità elementare, indispensabile per consentire la sopravvivenza degli individui. Gradualmente attraverso la religiosità aveva inizio quello che diventerà il percorso storico dell'individuo. Nel corso dei secoli la religiosità è stata protagonista nel fomentare divisioni e scontri fra individui, fino a diventare essa stessa generatrice di "principi d'intolleranza". Negli ultimi decenni l'afflusso di una moltitudine d'individui verso paesi con tenore economico di tipo occidentale ha creato problemi sociali d'adattamento fra popolazione autoctona e immigrati. Si tratta di manifestazioni d'intolleranza che rivestono costantemente una connotazione di tipo etnico-religioso, meno frequentemente all'inizio assumono i caratteri di rivendicazione di tipo sociale-politico. Le nuove frontiere tecnologiche, con la capacità capillare di influenzare le coscienze, hanno ampliato alcuni fenomeni d'intolleranza sociale. Attualmente l'Intelligenza Artificiale, oltre a rappresentare un'acquisizione che sicuramente migliorerà il rapporto uomo-società, facilitando l'individuo in tutte le sue manifestazioni, ha fatto sorgere drammatici elementi di riflessione. Potrebbe avere uno sviluppo

incontrollato, anarcoide, svincolato da norme che attualmente vincolano i rapporti interpersonali, o perfino deviare verso la più aberrante privazione dell'autodeterminazione dell'individuo, con conseguente deriva verso l'intolleranza ideologica.
